

Accessing papers via SAE Mobilus

As part of the degree program CertHe, FdSc and BSc(Hons) students have been provided with a user name and password to access papers published by SAE. SAE is one of a number of organisations where collision investigators publish their research.


Gaining access

Go to <https://saemobilus.sae.org/login/> and enter the user name and password provided by AiTS. This will take you to the home page.

You will know you are in the right place if you can see *Provided by Ai Training Services Ltd* below SAE Mobilus.





SAE organise their papers into collections and as such some papers that you search for will show up but will not be available as part of the collection. If they are unavailable you will see a padlock symbol (highlighted to the right). In the example to the right the search Criteria was *Searle* but his paper is not available as part of your collection as is shown by the padlock. You can still click on the title and purchase the paper if you require it, the cost is usually around £28.00.




Setting filters

To set a filter that only allows you to see papers you can access for free click on search again and in filters check the box that says **My Access** under SHOW ONLY. Now when you search you will only get results for papers you can download for free. Searching for pedestrians for example will return over 300 papers. You can now refine your results further by setting the filters that will have appeared.



Creating a dashboard

You can create your own dashboard which is an area personal to you where you can save searches. Click on the Dashboard tab and click on register now to create a free account. Use your own email address and your own password when you create a dashboard account.
